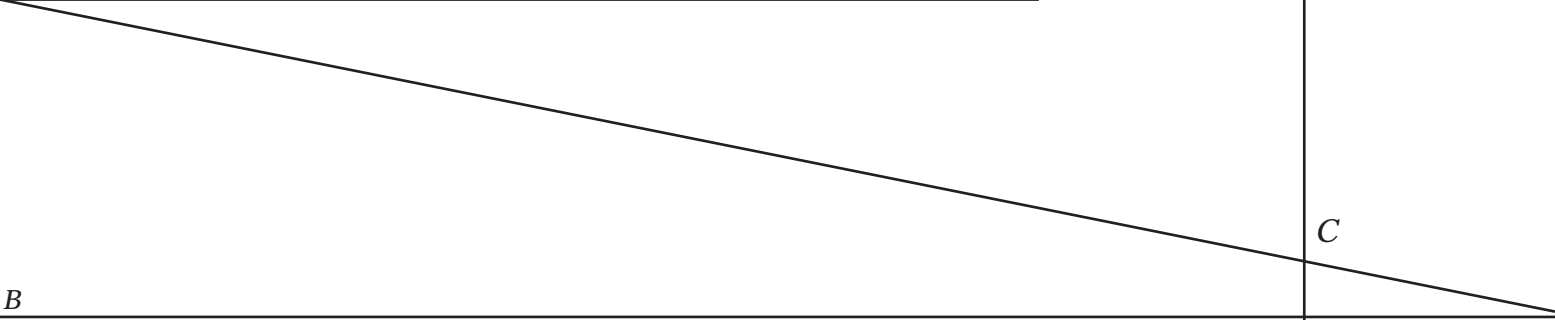

To find the lower-right corner for placing an image to be mounted in the "optical centre", place the print in the upper left-hand corner. Line A - A' bisects the distance from the print to the right hand edge of the matte. Line B - B' bisects the distance from the bottom of the print to the bottom of the matte. Point C , where a line from the bottom left hand corner of the to point B' intersects with the line from A - A' will be the lower right-hand corner of the image. This technique allows any size image to be mounted in the "optical centre" of any size of mount.
